- **Skate WA Artistic Meeting Update**
 1. Skate WA Camps. Current suggestions are: Freeskate: still pursuing Jayson to confirm unavailability, Dance: if Hugo isn't prepared to travel to WA then we should explore other international options with the possibility of sharing costs with NZ, Figures: Maricarmen Sanjuan revisit. All club members have been asked to let me know if they have any other suggestions and of your discipline preference.
 2. To accommodate League 1 in November the officials/coaches will be asked to set the 2017 Novice requirements at Novice Champs in August.
 3. WA States interstate judges: Jim Beard has accepted. Also approached are Lyn Cole and Seona Martin.
 4. Skate WA are looking for a Saturday venue contingency should it rain and we are unable to use Midvale. Malaga have indicated that they could

accommodate competitions from 5pm until late. If club members have any other suggestions of recreations centres that have three adjoining courts they have been asked to please let myself or Kat know.

5. Competition setup and packup: we need two volunteers from each club for setup and packup each day of competition, particularly at Midvale where we have to have raise and lower the nets.
6. Competition officials lunches: Morley will be catering for League 2 on Sunday March 13, League 3 on Sunday April 10. (Armadale will do L2 Sat Mar 12 and Cobras L3 Sat April 9).
7. Midvale competition layout: the judges table will move to the opposite side of the rink for all upcoming competitions, the calculators will move to next to the announcers, a mock judging table will be made available, the figure circles will need to be redone (volunteers will be called for), the floor will be cleaned with vinegar and the hockey players have been asked not to use liniment oil on the floor.
