Costumes: It is too late to put in an order for club jackets so we need to put out a request for ones that can be borrowed for the State Championships. We'll also need some for the Novice Championships. We are waiting to get a quote from Rhonda Bright regarding jacket orders, as she can arrange for smaller numbers to be ordered than previously required and a quick turnaround of 3-4 weeks.

Other business: Peter to check whether the artistic meeting will be held at League Three.

Resurfacing of the rink has now been finalised and redrawing of the figure circles is almost complete. There was some confusion when the rink closed for resurfacing, with a

few people thinking it was closing for good.

Gawaine Davis will be available on Sunday 29 May for private lessons at Morley after he finishes at Bunbury. Peter is to check with Ozzy about how to book lessons and inform our members.

Proficiency tests are needed for some of our skaters before the State Championships. Dance tests could be arranged at Morley on a Monday night.

Last year's State Championships did not include a dinner because of its coincidence with Mothers Day. If no dinner is arranged this year, we could organise one for ourselves.

We need to check when new State jackets will be required for the Nationals.

An information table to promote our club is planned for Wednesday 19 April during the school holidays. Ozzy will have information sheets for the rink. We might also target the Sunday before the State Championships for an information table, combined with artistic and speed skating demonstrations, that might encourage some potential or new members to watch the coming competition.
