#### **LEAGUE 4**

It seems to be a growing tradition that League 4 is hit by illnesses (largely winter flu) and exams (being now mid-year). But it was nonetheless well supported by Morley skaters, many taking the opportunity of a “last run” before the National Championships.

#### **NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS**

This is now looming close. Amongst the required preparations, almost all of our nominated skaters have already completed the ASADA anti-doping course (where required), and we are expecting new tracksuits any day now.

I will be discussing the issue with rink management, but not taking any action (if any is possible) before the Nationals.

#### **STAR CLASSES**

We have been told that Wojciech Bankowski has had to pull out of his assistance with Star Classes on Sundays. His contribution will be missed by many skaters, but it provides opportunities for newer coaches to make their mark. In particular, Tia Walker and Phoebe Nuttall have both done well, and while Phoebe hasn't formally registered for coaching training, her efforts in the Saturday class have shown that she could be a great coach.
