**Fundraising:** We made a profit of \$768 from the table at the Nationals and have some left-over stickers that can be sold later this year. \$50 was used to buy flowers for two of our former club members, Trudy Cottrell and Lorraine Kealley, who are retiring after many years of volunteering in the running of competitions.

**Constitution:** a start was made to rewording the constitution to bring it up to date with the current needs of the club and to introduce compulsory changes from the new act, such as in the sections dealing with conflict resolution.

**Other business:** club jackets have been ordered for 6 new members. Our subsidy will be \$35 per jacket. As there are now many new skaters, we need to ensure that the coaches explain club etiquette to them to avoid collisions etc.

Sue Brooks will be coming to Morley on the first Monday of each month to do lessons and the dance class from 4 pm onwards, with the aim of giving more instruction relevant to Rollart. We already have Allan Wehlow taking the dance class on the second Monday of each month.

Club registration will probably be on Sunday 2nd December as we need to avoid 9th December, which is a Speed training day. Our constitution website address needs to be added to the registration paperwork to inform new members.

Club members need to be informed both of the date for the AGM and proposed changes to the constitution as soon as possible.
