A second-hand costume sale held on Saturday 16 March drew less interest than we had hoped although some costumes were sold.

**Development competition:** This kind of competition seems well suited to the Cobras Club as they have paid members who are pre-competitive. The first competition on 13 April will be run by the Cobras but might have very few if any skaters from Morley and other clubs. If we do run the following competition, perhaps we should combine with the Armadale Club.

**Other business:** Very late payments for nominations for leagues will not be allowed.

One warning should be sufficient when families have missed the payment deadlines.

Some skaters were unhappy about the change at the last League to having figures at the end of the competition, which was done partly because we had a visiting judge who needed to leave before the end of the competition. However, the time needed to dismantle the staging needed for our new judging system means we must have figures last again at the coming league.

It would help if we could keep records of which proficiency tests have already been passed by our skaters so that we can be sure that they are nominating and practicing for the correct tests.
